

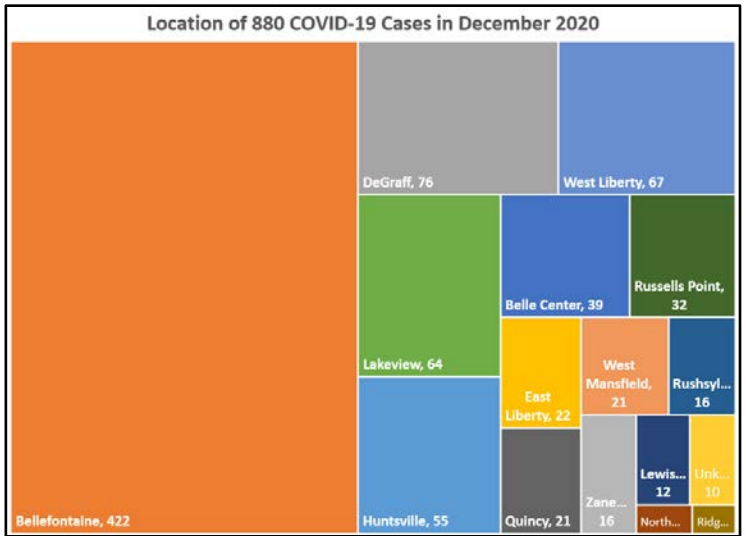
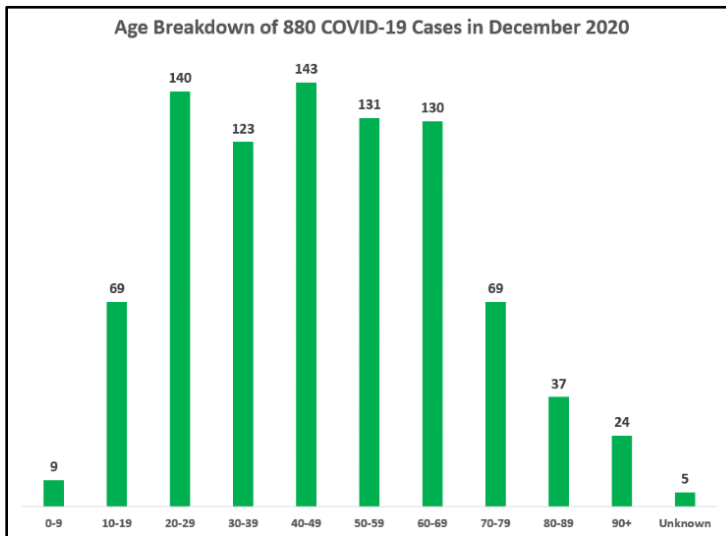
COVID-19 Situational Report

The information in this report covers: 12/01/2020 – 12/31/2020

As of 12/31/2020, 2:00 PM:

Ohio: 720,808 Total; 646,339 Confirmed; 74,469 Probable; Ohio Confirmed Deaths: 9,143

Logan County: 1,852 Confirmed + 622 Probable = 2,474 Total Cases. Of those 2,474 cases, 2,047 are presumed recovered*. | Deaths: 23 | Active Cases: 427



Ohio's Vaccination Program

A Phased Approach

During Phase 1 vaccine supply will be limited.

Vaccine administration will be focused on reaching critical groups.

PHASE 1A

- Health care workers and personnel, who are routinely involved with the care of COVID-19 patients
- Residents and staff at nursing homes
- Residents and staff at assisted living facilities
- Patients and staff at state psychiatric hospitals
- People with developmental disabilities and those with mental health disorders, including substance use disorders, who live in group homes, residential facilities, or centers and staff at those locations
- Residents and staff at our Ohio veterans homes
- EMS responders

All available vaccines will be administered to those who **choose** to receive it.

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PHASE 1B

GOAL: Save Lives

- Ohioans age 65 and older
- Those living with severe congenital, developmental, or early-onset medical disorders

GOAL: In-Person School by March 1st

- Adults who work in schools

All available vaccines will be administered to those who **choose** to receive it.

*Presumed Recovered is defined as cases with a symptom onset date ≥21 days prior who are not deceased.

ACTIONS COMPLETED SINCE LAST SITUATIONAL REPORT:

- Received first shipment of Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine (100 doses). Began distribution of vaccine doses to those in Phase 1A of ODH's Vaccine Distribution plan via scheduled clinics at LCHD office. - Held flu and other immunization clinics by appointment only. Call (937) 651-6186 with questions or to schedule.
- Continued monitoring of local and regional hospital bed situation as well as regional hospital census data.
- Provided two additional self-care, decompression session for LCHD staff stress due to overtime hours, public frustration, and the longevity of the pandemic.
- Continued to receive contact tracing assistance from ODH.
- Environmental Health staff continued to assist community planners to make indoor events as safe as possible.
- ODH continues accepting ALL retail and mask complaints.

- Continued to provide additional programs and services including vital statistics (birth & death certificates), WIC, food inspections, immunizations (limited and by appointment only), TB Testing (by appointment only), Narcan distribution, newborn visits (via phone), OCTF program and CMH program.

LIAISON:

- Unified Command (EMA, MRH & LCHD) continued to meet on a bi-weekly basis.
- LCHD staff meets with school administrators and school nurses to provide guidance on a weekly and as-needed basis.
 - Developed new processes and documents for school nurses/administrators to use in school contact tracing.
- Attended weekly calls with Governor DeWine and ODH to understand new orders and guidance as well as weekly calls with ODH for vaccine guidance.

LOGISTICS:

- Tested carbon dioxide levels, promoting fresh air exchange and indoor air quality in schools, businesses and churches as cold weather brings more people indoors.
- Provided advice and worked with Logan County Commissioners on building improvements, air quality advances and other COVID-19 related updates using CARES Act funding.
- Continued prioritized contact tracing by contacting only the positive case and giving instruction for the positive case to complete their own contact tracing using providing written guidance.
- Continued using automated one-calls to notify positive cases of test results and isolation & contact tracing instructions.
- Updated LCHD technology to meet additional demands.
