The Logan County Health District has moved to the Ohio Department of Health's (ODH) COVID-19 Vaccine online scheduling system and is no longer accepting waitlist registrations. Qualified individuals interested in receiving the vaccine can schedule an appointment by visiting <https://loganhealth.org/covid-19-vaccination/> and clicking the "Schedule the COVID-19 Vaccination" button. Qualified individuals can also visit <https://gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov/> to schedule an appointment.

To find out if an individual is qualified to receive the vaccine, visit <https://gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov/>.

ODH's online scheduling system allows Ohioans to view available appointment times and locations from different COVID-19 vaccine providers in an area, rather than contacting each individual facility. Keep in mind that not all provider locations are using the ODH scheduling system yet.

If you do not have internet access, options for scheduling are:

1. All six locations of the Logan County Libraries have computers with internet access for the public to use.
2. Call LCHD at 937-592-9040, Option 6 to leave a message for a volunteer to call you back and assist.
